Camp Groups Description

Group 1:

Open Adult Only

Suitable For: I just want to have fun and meet fellow saxophone enthusiasts.

- **Focus:** Having fun, no pressure, cultural immersion, and playing without pressure.
- **Objective:** This group can have a lighter playing schedule. Participants attend daily ensemble sessions and masterclasses. Participants can opt for individual lessons, and they can also be given time to audit other classes.
- **Requirements:** No audition video is required.

Group 2:

U12-16

Suitable For: High School / Equivalent AMEB/ABRSM up to Grade 6 Level

- **Focus:** Skill development and structured learning.
- **Objective:** Tailor their schedule to include two 40-minute private one-to-one lessons and daily ensemble practices. The rest of their schedule should be filled with dedicated practice room time and sitting in on other students' lessons. Incorporate elements of fine arts excursion activities and workshop activities, including visiting shows and rehearsing with concert bands. Students will present their results in the Gala Concerts.
- **Requirements:** You don't need to submit a video or certificate but should have at least 2–5 years of experience playing the saxophone in either school or lessons. You should be able to play the suggested songs

	from our list and perform in an ensemble group in the Gala Concerts. ● Suggested Repertoire:
<i>Group 3:</i> Rising Stars	Suitable For: High-level training and performance preparation for students who are preparing for exams and certification, or looking to study Music in the future. ● Focus: Polishing skills in ensemble music and gaining exposure to various professional environments in the music field. No age limits apply ● Objective: An intensive schedule featuring four 40-minute private one-to-one lessons and dedicated practice time. Key points for future development include tours to universities, rehearsals with an ensemble, learning repair and recording skills, and connecting with peers. ● Requirements: You should be able to play comfortably from our selected lists. See our list. You will be working with repertoire of a similar level in the ensemble and present a solo piece at the Gala Concert.
Group 4: University Conservatory and Concertos	Suitable For: Who wants to be Master Jedi of Saxophone ● Focus: A rigorous advanced group for those in higher-level saxophone music education. ● Objective: This group is for people who want to be the future Saxophone Jedi. You will have daily master classes and dedicated practice time with our International Artists. You will also be part of a mixed ensemble group with our faculty. During the music camp, you will have full access to any sessions and will be able to connect with local artists. We will select eligible participants from this group to play concerto with ensemble at Gala Concert.

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- **Requirements:** You have to be over 18 years old and confident in performing at a university degree level. We will request an audition video before we admit you into this group.
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
